**NEW PARISH OFFICE & CHURCH FOR PRIVATE PRAYER CLOSED NEXT WEEK** From Monday 25<sup>th</sup> August until Friday 29<sup>th</sup> August. The Parish Office will reopen on Monday I<sup>st</sup> September at 9.30am. It will be closed on Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> September.

THE POOLE-WAU PARTNERSHIP The link between the Poole & North Bournemouth Deanery and the Diocese of Wau in South Sudan, the Poole-Wau Partnership (PWP), was formed in 2011 by a resolution of our Deanery Synod. We aim to share our lives with our Christian sisters and brothers in Wau through prayer, by keeping in touch by e-mail, by visits, all of which can work both ways, and by financial aid, which is inevitably one way. PWP, a registered charity, depends principally on support from churches in the Deanery, as well as one-off and regular giving from individual supporters. We hold monthly Prayer Meetings and keep our supporters informed by means of a bi-monthly Newsletter and through our website, www.poolewaupartnership.com. For a decade, we have been supporting St John's College, which was founded with three students in 2012 in the cathedral compound in Wau, and has now grown to 300. We currently send £18,000 per year towards teaching staff salaries and other running expenses. We have also occasionally launched appeals to raise money for

particular projects: six of our Trustees and committee members visited Wau in February to attend the opening ceremony of the college's new building with four lecture rooms and three offices, for which PWP contributed 95% of the construction costs. I am looking forward to telling you more about our visit to Wau and about the Poole- Wau Partnership at both your Sunday morning services on 31st August. Mark Rathbone, Licensed Lay Minister and PWP Trustee. St John's will be taking a retiring collection at both the 8am and 10am for this work.
