**CHECK YOU ARE ELIGIBLE FOR PENSION CREDIT:** The Winter Fuel Payment is an annual payment to help you with heating costs during the colder months. The Government announced in July 2024 that, from this year onwards, to be eligible you must have reached State Pension age and also receive a qualifying means-tested benefit e.g. pension credit, universal credit or income support. The last possible date to make a successful backdated claim to receive the Winter Fuel Payment is 21 December. Applications for Pension Credit can be made on the <u>How to Claim</u> page on <u>GOV.UK</u> or over the phone by calling 0800 99 1234 (Monday to Friday 8am to 6pm). There is also a <u>Pension Credit toolkit</u> to help spread the campaign message to your audiences.
