# **NEW STOP PRESS FROM THE ECO GANG: APPLY FOR A FREE SWIFT BOX!**

Thanks to the Aviva Community Fund and Birds of Poole Harbour, the Dorset Swift Network are now offering free Swift boxes for suitable locations in Dorset. Swifts are desperately in need of our help. They have declined by over 50% in the last two decades, with fewer available nest sites and insect decline having a major impact on their numbers. We know that swifts are still hanging on in Broadstone but many nest sites have gone so this is a key area. If you can site

a box on a north-facing wall at a height of 4.5 metres or more, you can apply by emailing bookings@birdsofpooleharbour.co.uk or ring 01202 641003. Own installation required.
